Having heard learned Counsel appearing for the respective parties, in my considered opinion this petition can be conveniently disposed of by directing Respondent No.1 to dispose of the Petitioner's revision, copy of which is at Exhibit-"J" to this petition [page-64], as expeditiously as possible and preferably within the period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

2. Since substantial revision filed by the Petitioner is under consideration, it is necessary to protect the interest of the Petitioner during the pendency of this revision. Otherwise revision would be rendered infructuous. In that view of the matter, order of the Regional Joint Director of Co-operative

Societies passed on 28th March 2014 shall not be given effect to during the pendency and till the final disposal of revision. In the event the revisional authority passes an order against the interest of the Petitioner, same shall not be implemented for the period of two weeks from the date of service of such order on the Petitioner.

3. With aforesaid directions, writ petition is disposed of.
